Purpose of meeting: To hear La Croix UMC, Holcomb UMC, Perryville-Longtown, Marble Hill

I. La Croix

Jim Rust and Mike Stallion presented their plans for Phase III & IV for a new worship center and lobby. Phase III is approximately 35,000 sq. ft. and will provide seating for 1100. Phase IV is approximately 25,000 sq. ft. for children's nursery and education facility funding explained in brochure.

II. Holcomb UMC

Rev. Ruth Edwards and J. H. Dye presented their plans to rebuild, on the existing site, a new church to look very similar to the church that burned with columns in front. It will be on a slab with fellowship hall at the rear of the church. It will seat 100 parishioners. Insurance paid \$167,000. New cost: \$184,200 plus furnishings. Plans to ask for \$25,000 funding from the District Mission and Church Extension Society. Plan to break ground mid November or December 1st.

III. York Chapel UMC (Longtown)

Request by Rev. Michael Kelpé to enter into a lease with the rural Perry County Fire Association for the purposes of building a 3-bay firehouse.

IV. Marble Hill UMC

Discussions by Jerry McClanahan of Wednesday, October 17, 2001, meeting with the Trustees chair, Sherry Baker. Also present was committee member, Rich McAllister.

V. Rev. Denny Lumos

Brought committee up to date on work being done for the procurement of a new parsonage for the Wesley Foundation at SEMO University.
