

Southeast District Conference
June 9, 2004, 7:00 PM

Rev. Steve Breon, District Superintendent, opened the meeting at 7:00 PM with prayer. Approximately 50 persons were in attendance.

Jerry McClanahan began the discussion with the presentation of pictures of 1843 Ricardo, Cape Girardeau, as the site for the future home of the Hispanic Ministry parsonage.

Steve and Jerry made an offer on the property of \$110,000. The homeowner accepted the offer.

Paul Lanning gave an explanation of Hispanic Ministry growth. Jesus Es El Camino United Methodist Church has not yet been chartered, therefore brings the need for the District Conference approval of the property purchase. After the church is chartered, they will likely transfer ownership back to Jesus Es El Camino UMC, with maintenance, utilities, etc. coming out of Hispanic Ministry Budget.

Steve addressed the question related to 2005 District apportionments being raised. He stated firmly that all apportionments would remain the same.

The motion, stated

“The Southeast District Trustee/Board of Church Location and Building Team recommends that the District Conference approve the purchase of the property at 1843 Ricardo in Cape Girardeau, to be used as a parsonage for the District Hispanic Ministry. The purchase price is \$110,000 to be financed 100% at 5.1% interest for 5 years.”

Jerry McClanahan made a motion to accept the proposal for the purchase of the Hispanic parsonage. The motion was seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Rev. Bill Koch made a motion to adjourn the meeting. All approved and the meeting closed with prayer at 7:30 PM.
