

**OLD MCKENDREE BOARD OF TRUSTEES**  
**October 26, 2002**

The Old McKendree Board of Trustees held a special meeting at 10 AM, October 26, 2002, at the Old McKendree Chapel. Jack Byrd presided with the following members in attendance: Beverly Piepenbrok, Rodney Ladreiter, James Hartmann, Marybelle Mueller, Weldon Macke, David Myers, Betty Henry, and David and Theresa Hopkins.

The reason for the meeting concerned a gravel road leading to a potential homesite that has been connected to Old McKendree's lane about 65 feet from Bainbridge Road. Old McKendree's lane was on private property purchased by Old McKendree Association members in September 1928. The potential homesite does have direct access to Bainbridge Road.

Following discussion concerning legal costs, possible use by other property owners, etc., Weldon moved that the Board contact the Smiths and tell them that they can't use Old McKendree's lane and if they continue to use it, legal action will be taken. The motion was seconded by Rodney and passed unanimously. Jack will speak with the Smiths and attorney, Chris Weiss.

Weldon was authorized to gather information about the availability of SEMO University farmland that borders Old McKendree property for the future.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:20 AM.
