Parsonage/Office Location Team
And Trustees

Wednesday, April 30th, at 4:00 p.m. the SE District Trustees met to look at new property for the District Parsonage. Present were: Jim Overby, John Spence, Lois McRill, Denny Lumos, Marybell Mueller, and Jerry McClanahan. Absent were Michael Kelppe and Richard McAllister.

Marta Green and Teri Penrod, two members from our taskforce and very capable Realty Agents, showed us three homes. Two of which the Rev. Steve and Cindy Breon had previously viewed on Monday April 28th, these being 2140 Derbyshire and 2118 Sussex, both properties would be finished by June 15th. We were also shown another home at 2030 Minuteman Way. This home was unanimously chosen as the choice of the Trustees. The home was priced at \$262,000. Recommendation by the Trustees is to offer \$250,000. Then after an hour of discussion, they later voted unanimously that we offer, "Whatever it takes to get the job done"!

Teri will see that Rev. Ron Watts, chairman of the District Leadership Council, will tour the home, not only to give approval, but to discuss with Steve, Cindy and Brent, to allow us to call another District Conference, 10 days or more from this date.
